#### Music Notes:

**Joel Bejot** serves as Director of Music at St. Thomas Episcopal in Sun Valley, ID. Today's prelude and postlude selections are excerpts from the extraordinary composition Liszt wrote around the musical representation of the letters B-A-C-H, an homage to the great Baroque master.

This particular setting of "This is my Father's World" uses the familiar hymn tune, but Richard Walters' accompaniment has some recurring bits of dissonance and jarring rhythms, a nod to the messiness of beauty.

The aria "If With All Your Hearts" comes at a point in the Old Testament narrative where the people were in utter despondency because of the drought that God had brought on the land. Mendelssohn chose to smoosh together with a dash of creative license, two biblical texts for this aria's lyric; Joel 2:12 and Job 23:3.

"God So Loved" is an arrangement shared with me by Phyllis Donn, wife of the composer, in response to my request for fellow musicians to share their music for our pre-recorded audio services. The track was recorded during a service in 2015, and they were honored to share it with Redeemer, along with the message, "Love this very creative way to provide music for your congregation! Blessings to you and yours!"
